### **Don't Forget!**

- ✓ The Medical form must be filled out in its entirety and sent to the camp director by **June 7, 2019**. If this form does not accompany your camper(s), they will not be allowed to stay or participate in camp until it has been completed and sent in.
  
- ✓ Photocopy of front and back of health insurance card must be attached to this form.

### **What to Bring:**

- ✓ Any necessary medication(s)
- ✓ Proper outdoor attire (bring clothes that can get dirty, wet, and sticky!). Clothing that is lightweight, breathable, and dries quickly is best.
- ✓ Sunscreen
- ✓ Lip balm
- ✓ Bug spray
- ✓ Ball cap or hat
- ✓ Hiking boots or stiff-soled sneakers
- ✓ Clothes for warm and cool weather (please include a lightweight sweater or jacket)
- ✓ Rain jacket

### Clothing

- Expensive electronic devices
- Lighters or matches
- Valuable items

## **Does My Child Need to Pack Food?**

We will provide lunches and snacks for each day, plus dinner and breakfast for the overnight section. If your child wants to bring anything else to snack on during the day other than what we provide, they are very welcome. Water bottles will be provided, but they are welcome to bring their own as well.

## **Where Will We Meet?**

Because each day's activities will take place in a different part of the Valley, we will designate a drop off and pick up location for each day, according to our progression. Please refer to the schedule below for main locations. Unless otherwise indicated, **drop off will be at 8:00 AM and pick up will be at 5:30 pm in the same location.** There will be an alternate drop off and pick up location in Del Norte for those on the northwestern end of the Valley. Drop off will be at 7:30 am and pick up will be 6:15 pm for the Del Norte location only. We will notify you if there are any changes to the schedule.
